Subject:- Regarding payment of ex-gratia amount and monthly financial assistance to the family members of all the deceased Government employees regularly.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention on the subject cited above and to say that in CWP No. 22364 of 2014- Smt. Sona Devi Vs. the Director of Elementary & Others, Hon'ble High Court noticed that in the Education Department itself, a sum of Rs. 16 crores was due for a long time on account of payment of ex-gratia claim and monthly financial assistance to the family members of deceased government employee, which was paid only after this court sought the information. Director, Elementary Education, Haryana through an affidavit dated 12.12.2014 has stated that in order to dispose of 369 ex-gratia pending cases a sum of Rs. 16 crores has been released in the months of November and December, 2014. The ground taken for delay in the affidavit is that grant for the purpose was not received regularly. The Hon'ble High Court taken a serious view regarding the facts stated in the affidavit and passed the following directions on 15.12.2014:-

"Let Chief Secretary, Haryana file affidavit giving particulars of all the departments regarding the date up to which payment of ex-gratia amount under the Rule has been made and also as to how it will be ensured that in future, the payments shall be made regularly in all such cases."

2. The matter has been considered by the Government in view of above directions of Hon'ble High Court and it has been decided to fix the responsibility of Head of departments in case of any failure with a view to ensure that the payment of ex-gratia and monthly financial assistance be paid regularly to the family members of deceased government employee
