Subject: Self Assessment Reports for the year 2003-04.

It has been submitted in a representation by the HAUTA that in the SARs (for the year 2003-04) of large number of teachers, adverse remarks have been recorded/ conveyed. In general the contents of remarks as conveyed adverse are as under:-

"You have been rated/assessed as a good/very good scientist/teacher, however, you are advised to compete for projects from outside agencies or any other remarks of such nature."

2. The remarks of general nature as referred to above, where overall grading has been rated/assessed as good/very good/above, do not have any adverse bearing. It is pointed out that when a teacher is rated as 'Good' and above, the other observations of the nature referred as above and recorded in the SAR cannot be considered as adverse
3. In view of the facts stated above, it is clarified with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor that in such cases where overall grading has been given as good/above, the other observations of the nature referred to above in the SARs are not to be treated as part of the SAR.
4. You are requested to bring this clarification to the notice of concerned faculty and also place a copy in the SARs files of all the concerned teachers/scientists so that there is no complication at later stage.
