Subject:- Implementation of Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the Civil Appeal no. 3609 of 2017 titled Deepa E.V. Versus Union of India and ors.

The worthy Vice-Chancellor has ordered that decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case mentioned in subject must be followed.

Accordingly rule 11 of the prospectus 2017-18 is amended as under:

<p>First of all, seats in general category will be filled up. The candidates of reserved category who are able to find place in the general merit will be considered to have been admitted against the general category seats. Thereafter seats will be filled up as per reservation indicated in rules. A candidate who has secured admission in the first Counselling in the reserved category cannot be adjusted against general seat though his turn comes in the subsequent Counselling for the general category also. Seats lying vacant in any reserved category due to non availability of eligible candidates will be added to general category and filled up in 2nd Counselling.</p>	<p>For Admission to UG & PG Programme roster system mentioned in the prospectus will be followed. Admissions will be made in the respective category only in which the candidate has applied. Seats will be filled up as per reservation indicated in rules. Seats lying vacant in any reserved category due to non availability of eligible candidates will be added to general category and filled up in 2nd Counselling.</p>
<p>The children of persons having gross annual income of up to three lakh rupees shall first of all get the benefit of reservation in BC Category in admissions in educational institutions. The leftout quota shall go to that class of Backward Classes of citizens who earn more than three lakh rupees but up to six lakh rupees per annum. The sections of the Backward Classes earning above six lakhs rupees per annum shall be considered as creamy layer.</p>	<p>The children of persons having gross annual income of up to three lakh rupees shall first of all get the benefit of reservation in BC Category in admissions in educational institutions. The leftout quota shall go to that class of Backward Classes of citizens who earn more than three lakh rupees but up to six lakh rupees per annum. The sections of the Backward Classes earning above six lakhs rupees per annum shall be considered as creamy layer.</p>

This decision is to be implemented with immediate effect.
