**21.1.2017** : A function was organized in the memory of Bharat Ratan Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in the Auditorium of College of Basic Sciences & Humanities

Dr. K.P. Singh, Vice-Chancellor, CCSHAU was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Dr. Singh said that poverty, illiteracy and untouchability are curse on any society and country. With such curses no society can dream of development. Dr. Singh announced the establishment of Dr. Ambedkar Chair to put greater emphasis on the research and education with the motive to help the poor sections of the society. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was the first person who felt that illiteracy, untouchability and inequality are the evils which must be uprooted and he tried his level best to eradicate these.
