

Chrysanthemum Flower Show & Competitions

A two day Chrysanthemum Flower Show & Competitions was organized in the Botanical Garden by the Department of Botany & Plant Physiology in collaboration with Landscape Unit under the auspices of the College of Basic Sciences & Humanities, CCSHAU, Hisar on December 24-25, 2015. In this mega event, 80 Chrysanthemum varieties were displayed in the Botanical Garden that was admired both by the Chief Guest and all the visitors. This show was open to public for participation in different competitive categories like potted chrysanthemums standard (one large flower, many large flowers) as well as spray (small flower) types, potted foliage plants, potted palms, potted cacti and succulents, potted marigold, fresh flower arrangements etc. In addition to these competitive categories, on-the-spot drawing and painting competition, mehndi-rachao contest and rangoli competition for different age groups of school and college students were also organized. The topic for junior group school students (aged 7-12 years) was Clean India Green India and senior group school students (aged 12-17 years) were given My Dream City and the topic of college students was Climate Change and Agriculture. Students expressed their ideas and thinking on paper with beautiful coloured drawings which had been displayed.

The function was inaugurated by Mr. Anil Kumar Rao (IPS) Inspector General of Police (Hisar Range). Dr. R.K. Jain, Dean, College of Basic Sciences & Humanities welcomed all the guests and took them around the Botanical Garden.
