Ten years experience as Medical Officer under any State or Central Government after passing MBBS out of which at least two years experience should be after acquiring the MD/MS degree;

OR

Twelve years experience as Medical Officer under any State or Central Government after passing MBBS out of which at least three years experience should be after acquiring the PG diploma; and

- iii) Registered as Medical Practitioner with Medical Council of India or any other State Medical Council in Indian Union; and
iv) Hindi/Sanskrit upto Matric standard or higher education.
